SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submission Guidelines

The submission manual deals with the details of the submissions that can be made to the JSBF Blog, subject to the Style Guidelines. We are looking for contributions on any topic relating to banking, finance, technology, law, policy, and innovation, although these are indicative topics only. Contributions should adequately reflect critical thinking, policy constructs for the future, and may follow a multi-disciplinary approach. Blog posts should as far as may be possible, be of contemporary relevance, and may include opinion pieces, abstracts of research work published elsewhere, case summaries, and policy briefs.

Contributors are requested to submit their pieces along with a brief line or two, explaining what their piece is about, and what kind of contribution it is meant to be (report, policy brief, blog post, etc.), for more effective review. The word limit for blog posts is 500-1000 words unless it is a special issue and there is a specific call for longer pieces. Contributors are encouraged to follow the specified word limit for more effective writing.

Once the piece adheres to the Style Guidelines and the Submission Guidelines, the contributor is required to send the document file of the piece to JSBF Editorial Board email address i.e. <u>jsbfblog.editors@jgu.edi.in</u>.
